

RESPIRATORY CARE ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE DEGREE PROGRAM

The goal of the Respiratory Care Program (RCP) is to prepare graduates with demonstrated competence in the cognitive (knowledge), psychomotor (skills), and affective (behavior) learning domains of respiratory care as performed by registered respiratory therapists (RRT's). This program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Respiratory Care (COARC) and prepares graduates for national credentialing examinations which lead to certification and registry. Extensive adult and neonatal critical care experience is included as a part of this program. Major emphasis is placed upon cardiopulmonary critical care technology.

Although an open-door policy applies to the program's prerequisite courses, the Respiratory Care program has a separate admissions process. The maximum enrollment in this program is twenty-four (24) students entering each Fall.

Applications are accepted from April 1 – 15 each year for the following Fall program, and are ranked based on overall GPA (both from KVCC if available and from all applicable transfer institutions). Students must have all of the prerequisites successfully completed by the end of the Winter semester in which they apply.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. <u>If you are a new student</u>, first submit a general application for admission to Kalamazoo Valley Community College (<u>www.kvcc.edu</u>) listing "Pre-Respiratory Care" as your program choice. <u>If you are currently a KVCC student</u>, change your program choice status "Pre-Respiratory Care" by contacting a counselor at 269-488-4040. "Pre-Respiratory Care" will change Winter 2019 to "Health Science General Studies".
- 2. Provide the Admissions, Registration & Records Office with all official college transcripts, if applicable.
- 3. Past and current students must have an overall KVCC grade point average of 2.0 or greater in all subjects.
- 4. Schedule an appointment with a counselor at 269-488-4040 to develop a course plan and/or verify that you are on track to apply. This is a critical step to complete early in your admission process!
- 5. Complete the following prerequisite requirements by:
 - a. Taking and completing KVCC courses successfully.
 - b. Using transfer courses from other colleges when equivalent to the courses listed below.
 - Please keep in mind that if you choose to use transfer credit to meet any of the program's required courses, the <u>entire</u> GPA from each applicable school <u>will be included in your overall GPA</u> calculation. Applications are ranked by overall GPA.

Application Information:

If you have completed your prerequisite courses, or if they will be completed by the end of the Winter semester (late April/early May), you can obtain a Health Careers Application packet at www.kvcc.edu or by emailing healthcareers@kvcc.edu. Applications can also be found in the Health Careers wall rack located in the main hallway across from the Deans' Office, Room 7516 (TTC).

Application Period:

- COMPLETED applications may be submitted to the Information Desk by the Faculty Offices from <u>April 1 – 15</u> for entry consideration into the Fall program.
- Early applications <u>will be returned</u>.
- Admissions decisions will be sent via mail by June 15.*

*Please Note: In the event that the program is not full when seats are awarded in June, we will continue to take applications until the program fills. Students who are in their last prerequisite course(s) during the Summer semester are encouraged to check with the Health Careers Admissions Coordinator (healthcareers@kvcc.edu) regarding any potential seat openings and/or options for permission to take Respiratory Care courses that Fall.

Application Procedure:

- Submit all official college and/or high school transcripts (if applicable) to the Admissions, Registration & Records
 Office and <u>verify their arrival</u>. <u>Please make sure that you are awarded the required credit in order to meet prerequisites.</u>
- 2. Schedule an appointment with a counselor at 269-488-4040 to develop a course plan and/or verify that you are on track to apply. This is a critical step to complete early in your admission process!
- 3. Fill out the Health Careers Application packet and indicate Respiratory Care as your selection. Sign the Release Agreement and other parts of the packet. Make sure you submit <u>documentation</u> of all immunizations and <u>lab reports</u> required. Please note that a Rubella titer (#4 on the form) is REQUIRED.
 - a. The 2-step TB test and health physical can be completed AFTER acceptance into the program since these two items are only valid for one calendar year. The flu shot is not required at the time of application, however students MUST receive a flu shot each Fall during the program.
- 4. The Live Scan criminal background check and drug screen will be completed on campus AFTER acceptance into the program. The corresponding forms in the application packet must be filled out and signed at the time of application as a way of acknowledging that these items will be successfully completed if accepted.
- 5. Submit all application materials to the Information Desk by the Faculty Offices from **April 1 15**.

Admission Criteria:

- 1. Applications will be ranked based on **overall** GPA, both from KVCC (if available) and from all applicable transfer institutions.
- 2. The 24 students with the highest overall GPAs will be given seat offers first.
- 3. Additional eligible applicants beyond the 24 available seats will be placed on an Alternate List. This list will also be ranked by overall GPA, and will be used in the event that an accepted student decides to decline their seat. If this occurs, the next alternate on the list will be notified of seat availability as soon as possible.
